You will definitely have your hands full so we'd like to make it easy for you to get your puppy signed up for all the medical services and vaccines they'll need for their first year with our automatic, monthly credit card payment plan.

For just five monthly payment of **\$158.14 for male puppies** or **\$171.58 for females**, your puppy will have all of their health maintenance needs covered their first year.

*At the time of surgery, some dogs may need additional care that is not covered by this plan:

- Extract baby teeth to prevent crowding and food traps – the adult tooth needs a place to grow
- Remove floppy dewclaws that may tear, be painful and expensive to treat as an adult
- Hernia repair – sometimes there are small tears in the abdominal wall that need to be repaired.
- Crypt-orchid surgery for males when one or both testicles remain in the abdomen.
- The 20% Puppy Plan discount does apply any of these services. We'll give you an update about these conditions when you pet is six months of age.

We also suggest you check out our friends at Club K9 to learn more about how you can raise a friendly, social, well behaved canine citizen by adding one of their classes to the plan.

Our new neighbors, the friendly folks at Club K9, have partnered up with us to offer an enticing add-on to our Puppy Plans. We're very excited. Not only will you be able to obtain what's medically best for your new family friend, you'll also be able to begin some fun, helpful socializing work and basic training to help you understand how to be a great dog owner. We believe these two ideas go hand in hand. Please read a little more about this program....

Canine Confidence Class

This is our Puppy Kindergarten/ Beginning Dog Class. This is a beginning class for pups of all ages. It is great for young puppies, under the age of 4 mos., who will be having their first training and social experience in this class. It is also great for all dogs of any age that have already been well socialized but are in need of basic skills. Each week the class is divided into quarters. The first portion of class is used for off-leash socialization and recalls. During this portion of class pups develop confidence while learning how to play appropriately with their new friends. The humans in class learn about how dogs communicate with their body language and are educated in how to make sure that play is safe and appropriate. They also learn how to call their pups back to them and away from play.

The second portion of class is used to teach basic training skills such as sit, down, stand, off, watch me, wait, & stay. The third portion of class is used to educate families on how to raise their pups. This is an open discussion and problem solving session. Some of the topics we discuss are how to establish a positive relationship with our dog, how to handle chewing, how to stop jumping, & how to curb barking. The final portion of class is used for handling exercises. Clients are taught how to examine their dogs and spot common signs of illness. We talk about health and safety, and pups learn to be calm and settled when being touched, examined, having their ears cleaned, teeth brushed, nails clipped, etc.
